Please help us by separating plastics

With the enforcement of the Plastic Resource Recycling Promotion Act in April 2022, Haruna Village, Shibukawa City, and Yoshioka Town started separate collection of plastics from April 2024.

The collected plastics can be recycled into new plastic products at recycling facilities, thus reducing the carbon dioxide that would be emitted from burning.

Please help to realize a carbon-free society.

 PLASTIC WASTE	
TYPES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Plastic containers and packaging (with “plastic” mark) Examples: trays, packs/cups, plastic bags, tubes, labels, bottle containers (excluding plastic bottles), polystyrene foam, etc. ○ Plastic products (100% made of plastic) Examples: hangers, buckets, toothbrushes, CDs and other discs, sponges, silicone products, urethane products, toys without metal parts, etc.
DO'S AND DON'TS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Please put out in the village-designated pink bags. ○ Please wash soiled items thoroughly. If the stains cannot be removed, please dispose of these items as burnable garbage. ○ To facilitate sorting, put garbage directly into the designated bags, without any other bags. ○ Please cut hoses, vinyl tapes, and the like to less than 50 cm before disposing of them. ○ Garbage containing materials other than plastic (metal, rubber, wood, etc.) should be disposed of as burnable or non-burnable. However, there is no need to remove stickers such as price tags from lunch box lids or wrapping on fresh food. ○ Items that do not fit into the village-designated bags should be disposed of as oversized garbage. ○ Please do not put out PET bottles. (Labels and caps are OK.) ※ PET bottles have a special recycling process and need to be collected separately. Please use your local community's resource recovery center or stock house. Caps are collected at the stock house. Depending on the amount collected, UNICEF will send vaccines to children around the world. Your cooperation is appreciated. ○ Please do not put out business waste.
COLLECTION PLACES	<p>Please dispose of garbage at the collection station in your area. ※ Not accepted at the Recyclable Resource Stock House!</p>
COLLECTION DAYS	<p>Areas 1 – 8 Neighborhood Association</p> <p>Twice a month on second and fourth Wednesdays ※ until December 24/from January 14</p>
	<p>Areas 9 – 21 Neighborhood Association</p> <p>Twice a month on first and third Wednesdays ※ until December 17/from January 7</p>



BURNABLE GARBAGE

TYPES	Paper, food waste, textiles, incinerated ash, leather products, paper diapers, video tapes, etc.	
DO'S AND DON'TS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Please put out in the village-designated yellow bags. ○ Please do not put out business waste. ○ Please drain food waste thoroughly to reduce its volume. (More than half of food waste is water) ○ Items that do not fit into the designated bags should be disposed of as oversized garbage. 	
COLLECTION DAYS	Areas 1 – 8 Neighborhood Association	Twice a week on Mondays and Thursdays ※ until December 29/from January 5
	Areas 9 – 21 Neighborhood Association	Twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays ※ until December 30/from January 6



UNBURNABLE GARBAGE

TYPES	Aluminum cans, metals, glass, ceramics, dry batteries, button batteries, hair dryers, rice cookers, toasters, etc.	
DO'S AND DON'TS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Please put out in the village-designated white bags. ○ Please do not put out business waste. ○ Please make sure to empty gas cartridges and spray cans before disposing of them. ○ Please wrap any sharp objects in newspapers, etc. ○○ Items that do not fit into the designated bags should be disposed of as oversized garbage. 	
COLLECTION DAYS	Areas 1 – 8 Neighborhood Association	Twice a month on first and third Wednesdays ※ until December 17/from January 7
	Areas 9 – 21 Neighborhood Association	Twice a month on second and fourth Wednesdays ※ until December 24/from January 14



OVERSIZED GARBAGE

TYPES	Items that do not fit into the village-designated bags ※ Wood or pruned trees will not be collected.				
DO'S AND DON'TS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Collection days vary depending on the area. ○ There are items that cannot be disposed of as oversized garbage. (See "Uncollectible Garbage" below)

UNCOLLECTIBLE GARBAGE

(Please have the garbage picked up at a retail store, etc.)

TYPES	Gas cartridges, tires, pesticides, machine oil, paint, agricultural vinyl, farm equipment, construction waste, blocks, batteries, motorcycles, fire extinguishers, home medical waste, etc.
DO'S AND DON'TS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ This garbage will not be collected at the collection stations or oversized garbage disposal sites. ○ For agricultural vinyl, pesticides, and agricultural equipment, please contact an agricultural cooperative or another dealer. ○ For home medical waste, please check with the medical institution you visit or the pharmacy that prescribes the medicine.

Cannot be disposed of at the Cleaning Center.



RECYCLABLE WASTE

TYPES	PET bottles, glass bottles
DO'S AND DON'TS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Please adhere to the designated locations and hours for each neighborhood association. ○ Please clean the container and remove the cap. ○ Please remove the labels from plastic bottles and dispose of them without crushing.

Recyclable Resource Stock House

ACCEPTED WASTE	Plastic bottles, glass bottles, cardboard, newspapers, magazines, aluminum cans, steel cans, used ink cartridges, milk cartons, PET bottle caps, 1.8-liter bottles, beer bottles, used clothing, recyclable electronic devices, etc.
	<p>Please wash the inside of containers such as plastic bottles, glass bottles, and aluminum cans, and remove the caps.</p> <p>Please make sure to remove the labels from PET bottles. Please tie up cardboard, newspapers, magazines, etc. with a string.</p>
